Altar Servers assist Father George and the visiting Priests with special duties during regular daily and evening masses, Saturday, Sunday, and holidays.

Some of the duties are making sure the candles are lit, walking in the Cross, holding the bible for Father during his blessings prayers, help the Deacons prepare the altar, and ringing the bell.

You can serve at special Masses, like Christmas, Easter, Holy Week, Confirmation, First Communion, Feast Days, and now wedding masses.

If you have made your first communion and attend CCD regularly, they you can become an Altar Server once you training with our coordinator.

Parents are now responsible for making sure your child shows up 15 minutes before the Mass, assist them with putting on their cassock or albs (robes) and make sure they are returned properly.

If they are unavailable to serve on their scheduled date, it will be up to the parents to find another server to substitute. A list of phone numbers will be given when a new schedule is distributed each quarter.
