Requirements to enroll for Confirmation Preparation

Enrollment in Religious Faith Formation for the prior year either at St. Jude or another parish (proof from another parish is required). At St. Jude this class is called Pre-Confirmation.

Students will be at least 16 years old on April 1, 2019

Student will be in Sophomore, Junior, or Senior in High School (2018-2019 school year)

Have received Baptism and provide a Copy of the Certificate at time of Enrollment into Faith Formation

Attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation

Attend and Participate in a Confirmation Retreat
